# **SOUTHWESTERN RESOURCES FOR PI/PS STUDENTS**

## **PILC Summer Grant**

Southwestern's PILC conducts fundraising activities throughout the academic year to support and subsidize Southwestern students in full-time, unpaid clerkships in either the public interest or public service sectors over 1L and 2L summers. Through the PILC Summer Grant, students can apply for funding in amounts of up to \$5,000. **SUPPORT PILC when you can and spread the word!**

## **Public Service Graduate Program**

A resource for transitioning students/recent graduates is the Public Service Graduate Program (PSGP). Through PSGP, Southwestern will offer a modest stipend to support a postgraduate clerk position with a non-profit, public interest or public service agency.

## **Public Service Program**

Southwestern's Public Service Policy encourages students to perform at least 25 hours of pro bono public service each academic year, in addition to for-credit externships or legal clinic work. Students completing 25 pro bono hours in an academic year receive a letter of recognition from the Dean. Students who perform at least 75 hours of pro bono public service during law school receive a notation on their transcript and recognition at graduation. **Note:** work must be performed under the supervision of a licensed attorney and students may not receive compensation or academic credit.
